All businesses are prohibited from the sale, supply or distribution of the banned items in Southern Australia once the ban comes into effect in stages.

From 1 Mar, 2021


Plastic Straws Attached to Products

*The ban applies to bioplastic (PLA) alternatives.

Exemptions

Single-use plastic straws are excluded from the ban when attached to shelf-ready products. Exemption applies for straws supplying to people with a disability or medical needs.

From 1 Mar, 2022



EPS (foam) Packaging cups, bowls, plates & containers

*Prohibited from sale, supply or distribution.



Oxo-degradable Plastic Products

*Prohibited from sale, supply, distribution or manufacture/production.
